- Doctoral dissertation research: "A quantitative study: The indirect effects of implicit bias on the relationship between participant social group affiliation and emotional experiences." Utilized a quasi-Bayesian mediation design to study whether participant biases had a mediating effect on emotional valence and intensity in reaction to racial stimuli.
- Master's research into the affective components of hatred and social movement affiliation
 within hate groups, as framed through social, cognitive, and evolutionary psychological
 perspectives. Research included investigation of demography, composition, patronage, and
 social climates of where these groups and their membership originate and subsist. This
 research has continued, with findings presented at the Oklahoma Counseling Association
 conferences in 2014 and 2016.
